



In the Law of the Pack, a cub scout **gives good will** and in the Boy Scout Promise, a boy scout promises to **help other people at all times**. By participating in a [Scouting for Food](#) program, scouts come a step closer to fulfilling those words. Across the country, in many councils and districts, thousands of troops and packs with millions of scouts involved collect tens of millions of pounds of food which is distributed to needy neighbors.



- ❖ **Saturday, November 2nd at 10am**- Meet in the Scout Room to receive bags and street assignments for distribution. Distribution of bags must be completed by November 4th evening.
- ❖ **Saturday, November 9th**- Collection of all food stuff from all assigned streets no later than 11am, to be collected by 3 adult parents & scouts who were unable to participate in bag distribution.
- ❖ All food stuff collected is then brought to local distribution station.

Some tips to remember:

- ❖ All scouts wear uniforms when distributing and collecting bags
- ❖ Scouts stay in buddy teams (Parent is a scout buddy too)
- ❖ Begin distribution and collection after 9:00am, not earlier
- ❖ Hang the bags on front door - do not knock, but if the resident is outside or greets you, explain the program
- ❖ Do Not Distribute to residents with any kind of “No Solicitation” sign on home
- ❖ Only collect visible bags - do not knock or ask for bags
