Standard Rules for Camping and Overnight Scouting Events. These rules are BSA National Rules and will be enforced fully. Adults violating these rules will be dismissed from camp.

Guidelines & Rules

- Male and Female leaders and parents require separate sleeping facilities, assigned rooms or private areas. The only exception to this rule is on designated "Family Camp" events.
- Separate latrine facilities are available for Male & Female guests. Adults or Youth shall only use the facility marked to their gender.
- Knock before entering ANY private room and enter upon persmission.
- Showering for youths is from 6am-10pm. Parents are not allowed to shower with their child or assist their child with showering. Adult shower time is **only** when youths are sleeping from 10pm -6am.
- The Boys Scouts of America strictly **prohibits** the use of alcoholic beverages and controlled substances at encampments or activities on property owned and/or operated by Boy Scouts of America, or at any activity involving the participation of youth members.
- All scouting functions, meetings and activities should be conducted on a smoke-free basis, with designated smoking areas located away from all participants.
- **Two-deep leadership**: Two registered adult leaders, or one adult and a *parent of a participating scout*, one of whom is at least 21 years of age, are required for all trips or outings.
- All scouts will adhere to the Buddy system. The policy of the Boy Scouts of America is for boys to be
 active but in groups of no smaller than two. Individual Scouts are required to find a buddy (another
 Scout or parent) when they are participating in Scout functions. This includes going to the car,
 restrooms, on walks etc.
